











Adverses reactions

REACTION	MOLECULE	CAUTION	ESSENTIAL OIL*
Allergy 	limonene, linalool, geraniol, citronellol, lactone alpha pinene	asthmatic, people with allergy, do not use for a long time	Lemon Cinnamon Laurel/Bay leaf Peppermint Palmarosa
Hepatotoxicity 	Phenols (>50%) Menthol Pulegone Cinnamylaldehyde	kids, pregnant women, people with hepatic pathology, use during a short time	Oregano Savory Thym thymol Peppermint Fennel Aniseed
Hormon like 	Sclareol Anethol Viridiflorol Cedrol	pregnant women, kids, people with hormone dependant cancer or fibroma	Clary Sage Sage Officinale Vetiver Rosemary Verbenon Fennel Aniseed
Dermocausticity 	Phenols Carvacrol Thymol Aldehydes	do not use by rectal route, very diluted by dermal route	Cinnamon Eucalyptus citriodora Wintergreen Spike lavender Mandarin Eucalyptus radiata Oregano
Abortion 	Ketones Verbenon Menthone Carvone Camphor Italdione	strictly forbidden for pregnant women and kids	Spike lavender Peppermint Palmarosa Rosemary camphor Rosemary Verbenon Sage officinale
Neurotoxicity 	Ketones 1.8 cineole Monoterpenes	forbidden for young kids or for people suffering from epilepsy, not advised for children under the age of 6	Fennel Cedarwood Aniseed Spike lavender Lavandin super Peppermint Sage officinale
Photosensitivity 	Coumarines	no sun exposure after use	Bergamot Lemon Mandarin Orange

REACTION	MOLECULE	CAUTION	ESSENTIAL OIL*
Nephrotoxicity 	Monoterpenes	usage on a short period at low dose, do not ingest	Scot pine Cypress Juniper Fir balsam Green mandarin Peppermint
Irritation 	Limonene, citral, eugenol, menthol, alpha pinene, citronellal	test the product by applying a little in the crook of your elbow	Lemon Tarragon Marjoram Laurel Juniper Tea tree Ylang ylang
Bleeding disorders 	Coumarine, Salicylate, methyl	do not use with an anticoagulant treatment, in case of haemophilia or in a haemorrhagic context (surgery)	Wintergreen Lemon
